

ADULT VOLUNTEER CODE OF CONDUCT

A primary goal of the Victoria Livestock Show adult volunteer is for each individual to be a positive role model for our youth and their families. Our membership serves in support of our local 4–H and FFA programs and an extension of positive influences those organizations provide for our Victoria Livestock Show participants. Each adult volunteer is expected to adhere to the following guidelines of ethical behavior and conduct:

- Exhibit fairness and good sportsmanship
- Exhibit honesty
- Exhibit use of appropriate language
- Shall NOT participate in behavior that is illegal, unsafe, or disrespectful to others
- Shall NOT possess or use illegal drugs
- Shall NOT abuse legal drugs or alcohol, or be "physically impaired or under the influence" when serving in the capacity representing Victoria Livestock Show
- Shall be respectful of public and private property

VOLUNTEER UNDERSTANDING AND AGREEMENT OF CODE OF CONDUCT

I hereby acknowledge having read the Victoria Livestock Show Code of Conduct and agree to adhere to the guidelines outlined in the Code of Conduct. I understand that my placement as an adult volunteer for the Victoria Livestock Show is contingent upon my agreement to adhere to these guidelines and my failure to abide by these guidelines could result in my loss of privileges. Consequences may also include suspension by show management acting in their capacity, and that may include the involvement of law enforcement officials.

The Victoria Livestock Show is committed to providing a positive educational experience for our participants, and high moral standards are expected to be exhibited by our adult volunteers in leadership.
